

INAUGURATION OF DAYALAYA

Dayalaya is a Centre for Vedanta Studies. Pujya Swami Dayananda Saraswati laid the foundation stone for this Centre on February 6, 2012. Dayalaya is situated in Periya Thadagam Village on the foothills of Sri Anuvavi Subramanya Temple, Coimbatore. It is 2 km off Thadagam Road, 10 km before Anaikatti Gurukulam. Dayalaya is a division of Shri Lalithambika Trust which manages the well-known Shri Lalithambika Temple.

Swami Jagadatmananda is the Acharya of this Centre. He is an ardent devotee of Pujya Swamiji from 2000. He was given sannyasa diksha by Swami Sakshatkritananda during Sivaratri 2017. His purva asrama name was Dr. Jagannathan. He has a doctorate in Value Education from Madurai Kamaraj University. He has studied Vedanta from Swami Paravidyananda, Coimbatore.

Swami Sadatmananda, Chief Acharya, AVG, Anaikatti inaugurated Dayalaya on May 29, 2017. He told that Dayalaya will be a Centre for study of Vedanta, Sanskrit and Vedic Astrology.
